



PLAY

Hold up a baby doll and let each child hold and rock it. **God worked through a family and a baby to show that He keeps His promises! God sent a baby to a mommy and daddy even when it seemed impossible. Let's take care of the baby!** Allow each child to hug and care for the baby doll.

BIBLE

Sit on the floor with the babies and open a Bible. Read the story of God's promise to Abraham from Genesis 15:5 and 21:1–3. Say: **God promised Abraham that He would have as many children as stars are in the sky. God kept His promise, and Abraham had a big family, starting with baby Isaac. God keeps His promises. We can trust Him!**

PRAY

God, thank You for loving us and always doing what You say You'll do. Help us trust You and remember that You keep Your promises, no matter what. We love You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

SING
