*'READ THE BOOK, DONT WAIT FOR THE MOVIE'*

*Don began a new series about the Bible on Sunday.*

*Can we trust that the scriptures are the word of God?*

*We need revelation if we are ever going to know about God, or know Him personally.*

*Read together Psalm 19.*

*This Psalm outlines three forms of revelation – general, specific and experiential.*

- What are our thoughts as a group about whether the Bible is totally the word of God? Have we struggled at times to believe it is?
- Thinking about Don's message, how do some critics undermine the truth of the scriptures? How has archaeological evidence for example, been found to support people and places spoken of in scripture?
- Discuss as a group your understanding of general, specific and experiential revelation from God?
- Why is it important to balance these different types of revelation with each other?
- Why might it be important to take into account what we see revealed in scripture, both generally and specifically, when God reveals something to us via an experience of Him?
