In God's big story, we saw how God saved the people He loved, despite their complaints and sin. Only God has the power to save, and through His Son Jesus, He made the way for us to be saved.

Sit down as a family and share stories about friends or family members God has saved. Maybe God has helped them through a difficult time, like an accident, or God has saved them from their sin, and their lives show the wonder and love of Jesus to others.

Ask one or two people if they'd be willing to share the story of how God saved them with your child via video call. There's power in the testimonies of God's people, and this call has the potential to increase your child's faith! Also consider sharing about how God has saved you! It can be your salvation story or a recent story about how God is saving you in or through a difficult situation. Kids love hearing stories about their parents' lives!



WALK IT ACT IT MOVE IT Hide and Rescue!

Invite your family to play a game called Hide and Rescue. Have everyone dress up as superheroes. They can tie a bright long-sleeve shirt around their shoulders as a cape or make a simple mask with construction paper and ribbon. Encourage your child to use imagination and surprise the family with fun costume ideas. To play, choose one person to be the superhero rescuer. The rescuer closes her eyes and slowly counts to 20 (or as high as she can!) while everyone else hides. When she finishes counting, she opens her eyes and calls, "Ready to rescue!" The people hiding can softly whisper, "Help!" as she searches. When the rescuer finds someone, that person joins the rescue team and helps find the others. Play several rounds so everyone gets a turn being the rescuer. After the game, talk together: **God sent Jesus to save us from our sins (the wrong things we do) so we can live forever with Him. God is the true rescuer—only He saves!** Discuss:

- What word would you use to describe God?
- How do you think God feels about you?
- What's one way God has rescued you?
