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Moses' Tabernacle was a portable sanctuary built by the Israelites at God's command as a dwelling place for His presence and the centre of worship during their journey through the wilderness and into the Promised Land.

EXODUS 20:18 (NKJV)

Now all the people witnessed the thunderings, the lightning flashes, the sound of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking; and when the people saw it, they trembled and stood afar off.

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EXODUS 19:12 (NKJV)

You shall set bounds for the people all around, saying, Take heed to yourselves that you do not go up to the mountain or touch its base. Whoever touches the mountain shall surely be put to death.

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EXODUS 19:21 (NKJV)

So the people stood afar off, but Moses drew near the thick darkness where God was.

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EXODUS 24:1-2 (NKJV)

Now He said to Moses, “Come up to the Lord, you and Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel, and worship from afar. And Moses alone shall come near the Lord, but they shall not come near; nor shall the people go up with him.

“Then Moses went up into the mountain, and a cloud covered the mountain.”


EXODUS 40:34
