WHY ARE WE MOVING?

We spent a significant amount of time exploring options that would allow us to provide a home for future generations.

Our current building is ageing, with leaks and other issues. Upgrading would have cost \$13 million, making it difficult to meet on-site for two years and only extending its lifespan by about 20 years. A full rebuild was estimated at \$30 million an amount we couldn't afford to borrow.

Buying 490 Grey Street was the best financial

option, providing a long-term home for at least 50 years while keeping debt as low as possible.

This decision was prayerfully considered and supported by our Elders, Trustees, and Advisory Board and endorsed by our church family (99% in favour). We have felt a sense of the Lord's peace, leading and guidance on this move.

HOW DID WE PAY FOR 490 GREY STREET?

We purchased the building using money in cash reserves, bank lending and vendor finance.

Following the eventual sale of 950 Victoria Street and 17 Clifton Road and because of your Pledge490 contribution, we will have sufficient funds to repay the majority of our lending, and we celebrate that we are in this wonderful position.

WHEN ARE WE MOVING?

We hope to move in before the end of 2025.

WHAT DO WE NEED?

To complete the fit out, we need to raise an extra **\$4–5 million**. The less we borrow for this, the stronger our financial position will be.

WHERE WILL I PARK?
